Dear Esteemed Member,

Receive Christian Greetings from the Christian Health Association of Kenya secretariat. I share in this circular two urgent regulatory issues affecting our operations and service delivery:

01. KMPDC CIRCULAR 22 SEPTEMBER 2026 — ZERO TOLERANCE

- Doctors: Lending your registration number, practising licence, stamp, signature to another person to obtain SHA/insurance pre-auth or billing = personal liability, suspension/cancellation of licence, civil + criminal fraud charges.
- Hospitals: Allowing unqualified personnel to perform major invasive procedures or using another doctor's credentials to bill = facility licence suspension/cancellation

Proposed IMMEDIATE ACTION:

1. Keep an updated database of all health care workers
2. No clinician to share credentials. Each procedure must be done by licensed person present
3. In-charge to audit theatre registers vs duty roster on a daily basis
4. Ensure all visiting specialists have valid 2026 practising licence filed.
5. Ambulance operators: register with KMPDC before 30 Oct 2026 for 922 emergency system — free.

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02. FAMILY PLANNING STOCK-OUT — NATIONAL CRISIS

As reported by KEMSA and Senate on 24-25 Sept:

That KEMSA is stocked out of Combined Oral Contraceptives (COCs) and Progestin-Only Pills (POPs) until December 2026. Nation check shows 13 commodities at zero — including DMPA injectable, implants, condoms, emergency pills. Shortage due to only KES 500M allocated vs KES 3B need + KES 600M unpaid KEMSA debt after donor transition.

IMPACT ON CHAK SERVICE DELIVERY

Clients sent away, rise in unplanned pregnancies and attendant complications.

WHAT CHAK ASKS YOU TO DO:

1. Document: Daily stock-out form — send to CHAK Programs by Friday via: secretariat@chak.or.ke; copy Dr David Muchina via dmuchina@chak.or.ke. We need evidence for further advocacy for adequate supplies.
2. Keep updated records of the stock levels for uploading onto the CHAK Commodity Security Platform
3. Participate in the CHAK MHU webinars for regular updates and corrective actions
4. Manage: Use available methods — counselling, natural FP where in line with faith, referral within network for methods you don't provide, ensure implant/IUD removal still offered.
5. Do NOT buy from open market without PPB verification — risk of counterfeit.
6. Communicate with compassion to the affected clients, offering alternative solutions
